# What is an AP Pre-administration Session?

An AP Pre-administration session is a gathering of all students who will be taking AP exams for the purpose of completing mandatory paperwork in advance of the testing.

# What should I bring to the AP Pre-administration Session?

Each student should bring a sharpened #2 pencil. If students want to use social security number for identification purposes (which is optional) they should be sure they know the correct number. Students should be consistent from year to year, so keep that in mind when using your SS number. Students will also be asked to indicate the highest level of education completed by their parents or legal guardians. Students who do not know the answer to these questions should ask their parents **before** the preadministration session.

What if I'm absent from school on 4/15 and miss the AP Pre-administration Session?

Attending the AP Pre-administration session is <u>mandatory</u> before taking an exam. If you miss the session on 4/15, it will be your responsibility to attend a make-up session listed below (no food will be provided.)
