## Dress Code Reminder

Parents and Students, as warm weather returns, please make sure that you review the dress code policy found in your planner. #### FCAT information

The Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test, FCAT 2.0 will be administered this Spring April 7<sup>th</sup> through April 25<sup>th</sup> to all eligible students in grades 3-11. The following are the testing windows for WRHS students:

FCAT 2.0 Retake 11th and 12th grades is April 7-11, 2014.

FCAT 2.0 Reading 10th grade is April 14-18, 2014.

FCAT 2.0 Reading 9th grade is April 21-25, 2014.

Retake students are all Juniors and Seniors who have moved to Florida and not yet taken the FCAT, Juniors and Seniors who have yet passed FCAT and Retained Sophomores who did not pass FCAT. All students who are scheduled for FCAT 2.0 testing will receive testing information including dates and locations from their teachers. Students are encouraged to get a good night's rest and eat breakfast before coming to school on testing days.
