Students must understand that **driving an automobile to WRHS and parking on school property is a privilege** and not a right. We retain the right to revoke parking privileges at any time during school year for violations of the Student Code of Conduct or the Parking Procedures. Neither WRHS nor the School Board of Pasco County School District is responsible for any theft, damage, vandalism, or mishap that may occur to any vehicle parked on the campus of Wiregrass Ranch High School.

Students who continue to park their car at school without permission or authorization are subject to being towed at their own expense.

I have read and understand the rules regarding parking at Wiregrass Ranch High School, agree to abide by the rules, and understand that failure to do so will result in the suspension/revocation of my parking privileges.

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Wiregrass Ranch High School Parking Procedures

Parking at Wiregrass Ranch High School is a privilege. When a student wants to park on campus during the school day, their vehicle must be properly registered. Please review all Parking Procedures with your parent/guardian.

GUIDELINES

1. Limited parking spaces are provided for students in the parking area. Student parking is in designated areas only; there is no parking on the grass, in the fire lanes, faculty/staff areas, or in visitor parking areas.
2. Do not back into a parking space at any time. Head in parking only! Use only one space per vehicle.
3. Juniors and Seniors who qualify (see below) may purchase parking tags. The remaining tags will be sold through a lottery to qualified students.
4. Loitering in the parking area is not permitted. After entering the parking area, all students must leave their cars immediately, report to class and remain on campus the entire school day. If a student leaves campus without signing out through Student Services, his/her parking tag will be revoked.
5. Cars are not to be used as lockers; students should return to their cars only when leaving school at the end of the day or after signing out in the Student Services office.
6. Students who have been approved to work during the school day may leave only at the appropriate time and park only in the designated area.
7. All traffic laws will be enforced for the safety of everyone.

QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify for a parking tag a student must:

1. Have a valid operator's license, proof of insurance, and a proof of residency that matches the address on the driver's license.
 - a. Copy of a utility bill
 - b. Copy of a properly executed lease agreement
 - c. Copy of a mortgage statement
 - d. Copy of an affidavit of residence
2. Pay a \$15.00 fee.
3. Be cleared of all school obligations from the previous year(s).
4. Have an unweighted 2.0 cumulative GPA.
5. Meet district attendance requirements.
6. Attend and complete the WRHS Driver's Safety Class.

PARKING TAG REGULATIONS

1. Once issued, the parking tag cannot be altered. Tags must be permanently and visibly displayed on the front windshield.
2. Any changes to your permit information, such as a new vehicle or license tag, must be made immediately and can be done at no cost.
3. A parking tag may not be removed for any reason other than to turn it in. Consequence: The parking tag will be revoked.
4. Replacing a lost permit cost \$15.00

SUSPENSION/REVOCATION

A student's parking privilege may be suspended or permanently revoked for the following reasons:

1. Failure to maintain an unweighted 2.0 GPA
2. Being in the parking area during the school day without permission.
3. Transferring or receiving a parking tag that belongs to another vehicle.
4. Parking in unauthorized areas.
5. Exceeding the 5 mph speed limit in the parking area.
6. Reckless driving and/or speeding in the parking lot, or within the perimeter of the school grounds.
7. Excessive absences, tardies to school and/or failure to meet the districts' attendance policy requirements and student code of conduct.
8. Leaving campus without permission.

MISCELLANEOUS

1. If a student's parking privilege has been revoked or denied, under no circumstances will that student be granted a temporary parking permit.
2. Vehicles displaying words, graphics, or designs that are poor in taste or create disruption, in the opinion of the WRHS administration, are prohibited.
3. To ensure the safety and protection of the student population, Florida Law provides for a search of any vehicle on campus by the administration upon reasonable suspicion that a violation of the Code of Student Conduct is occurring at the school or a school function.
4. Students who continue to park their car at school without permission or authorization are subject to being towed at their own expense and/or receive consequences related to defiance.
