WRHS Dress Code

In order to promote an orderly learning environment in our school while preparing all students for later success in the world of work, the District School Board of Pasco County and WRHS has established the following rules for student dress:

- Students may not wear pants, shorts or skirt less than 4" above the knee; or, skin fitting pants such as 0 leggings or yoga pants that do not meet other dress code requirements.
- All Pants must be worn securely at the waist.
- No undergarments should be exposed. 0
- Blouses, shirts, and sweaters cannot dip below a line formed between the right and left armpit. Muscle shirts 0 and tank tops are not permitted. Spaghetti straps and strapless tops are not acceptable. Tops must be long enough to clearly overlap the belt line or stay tucked in during the course of normal movement throughout the school day.
- Pajamas are not permitted to be worn at school unless previously approved by the principal for special school activities.
- Students shall not wear hats or head coverings on the school campus during the regular school day unless previously approved for medical or religious reasons or special school activities as determined by the principal or her designee.
- Students shall wear shoes for foot protection and hygienic reasons while on school grounds. Slippers are not 0 acceptable.
- Decorations, symbols, mottos, or designs imprinted or attached to the body or clothing which are offensive to good taste or the maintenance of decorum shall not be worn to school or school functions.
- Clothing that advertises tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or identifies them as members of an antisocial group or 0 gang shall not be worn to school or school functions.
- Jewelry shall be worn in a way that does not present a safety or health hazard or cause a major disruption to 0 the educational process. Spiked jewelry, wallet chains or dog collars shall not be permitted.

Consequences:

- 1st Violation: Verbal warning issued by IA or Administrator 0
- 2nd Violation: Lunch Detention issued by IA or Administrator 0
- 3rd Violation (and thereafter): Referral for defiance, After School detention with increasing discipline for 0 each additional referral.
