

Do you know what it takes to be University Bound?

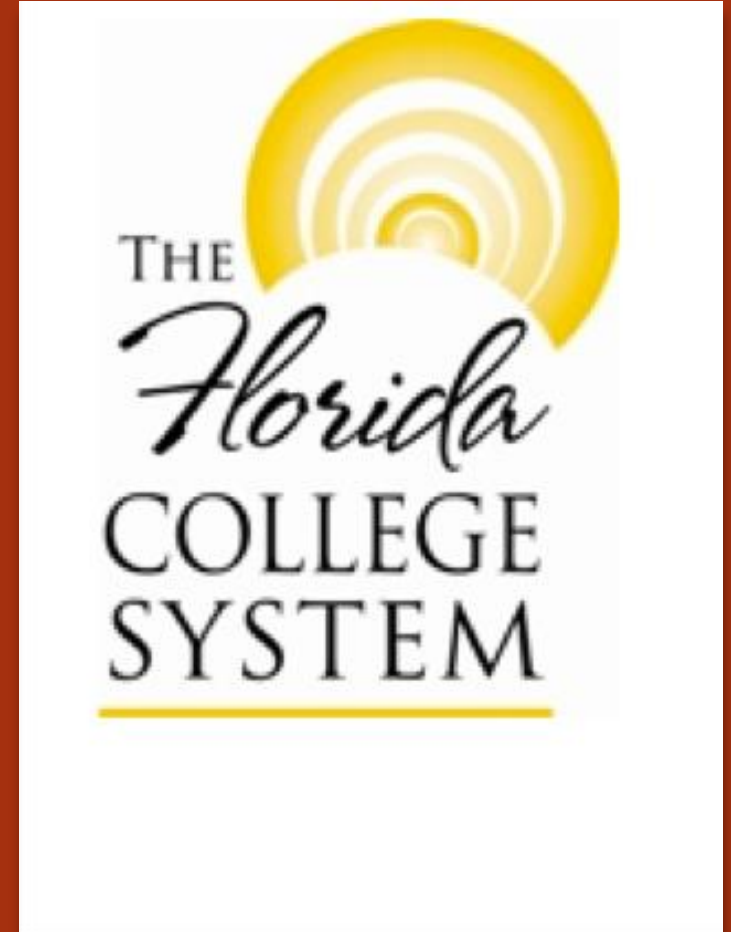
If you decide that you want to apply to a 4-yr university immediately after high school, make sure you are reviewing the admissions pages & looking at their 'Freshman Profiles'.
