



Wiregrass Ranch High School Parking Procedures and Policies



Parking at Wiregrass Ranch High School is a **privilege**. When a student wants to park on campus during the school day, their vehicle must be properly registered and parking procedures and policies followed. Review all this document with your parents and guardians.

Students must take the [Safe Behind the Wheel-Wiregrass](http://wrhs.pasco.k12.fl.us/student-parking-at-the-ranch/) course before purchasing a tag. Go to <http://wrhs.pasco.k12.fl.us/student-parking-at-the-ranch/> complete the course and quiz. Print out and bring your score report with you to purchase a tag.

Guidelines:

1. There are limited spots for students in the student parking lot; there is no student parking in the grass, fields faculty/staff or visitors' sections. Student must remain in cars until they are ready to attend class. There is **no congregating** in the parking lot before or after school and students must adhere to social distancing guidelines/flows upon arrival/departure of campus.
2. You must qualify to purchase a parking tag and follow parking policies and procedures, or your privilege will be revoked.
3. There is no loitering in the parking area. All students must leave their cars immediately and not return until the end of their school day. Your vehicle cannot be used as your locker. Masks must be worn prior to exiting the car and must remain on in the parking lot. Students can remove their masks once they've entered their car at the end of the day.
4. Students must park in their assigned spots.
5. Leaving campus in your vehicle before the end of your school day without properly signing out will result in your privileges being revoked. Students may **NOT** leave for lunch unless you have 7th period lunch on your schedule.
6. Vehicles are to be parked safely, quietly and in your own space. All traffic laws will be enforced for the safety of everyone.
7. Parking tags can't be altered and must be hung from rearview mirror.
8. Drivers must report to student services any changes in the vehicles they are driving, tags or insurance.
9. Vehicles displaying words, graphics or designs that are in poor taste, offensive or cause a disruption in the opinion of WRHS administration will be prohibited.
10. To ensure safety and protection of all at WRHS, Florida Law allows all vehicles to be searched by WRHS administration upon reasonable suspicion that a violation of the student code of conduct is occurring anytime the car is parked on campus.
11. Any student without parking privileges or has had their privileges suspended/revoked and continues to park on campus is subject to have their vehicle towed at owner's expense and/or receive consequences related to defiance.

Qualifications: A student must:

1. Have a valid operator's license and proof of insurance and proof of residency (utility bill, lease agreement, mortgage statement, affidavit of residence)
2. Pay a \$40.00 parking fee
3. Be on track in the Bull's Pride Program
4. Proof of taking the Driver's Safety Course listed above

Suspension/ Revocation of Parking Privileges

Students that are off track for Bull's Pride may go through the appeals process. Parking privileges may be suspended for a quarter/semester or year. Anyone student that has parking privileged removed will be issued a bus pass.

Students violating parking policies/procedures outlined above even if it does not place the student off track for Bull's Pride

1st infraction: Parent called and a warning issued

2nd infraction: Parking privileges will be revoked for 6 weeks

3rd infraction: Parking privileges will be revoked for 12 weeks

4th infraction: Parking privileges will be revoked for the remainder of the year

Complete this form, bring all required documents and \$40.00 fee to purchase a hang tag.

Student Parking at WRHS is a privilege and not a right. We retain the right to revoke parking privileges at any time during the school year for violations of the student’s code of conduct or parking procedures as well as off track status for Bull’s Pride. Neither WRHS nor the School Board of Pasco County School District is responsible for any theft, damage, vandalism, or mishap that may occur to any vehicle parked on the campus of Wiregrass Ranch High School.

I have read and understand the rules and regulations regarding parking at Wiregrass Ranch High School, agree to abide by the rules, and understand that failure to do so will result in the suspension/revocation of my parking privileges.

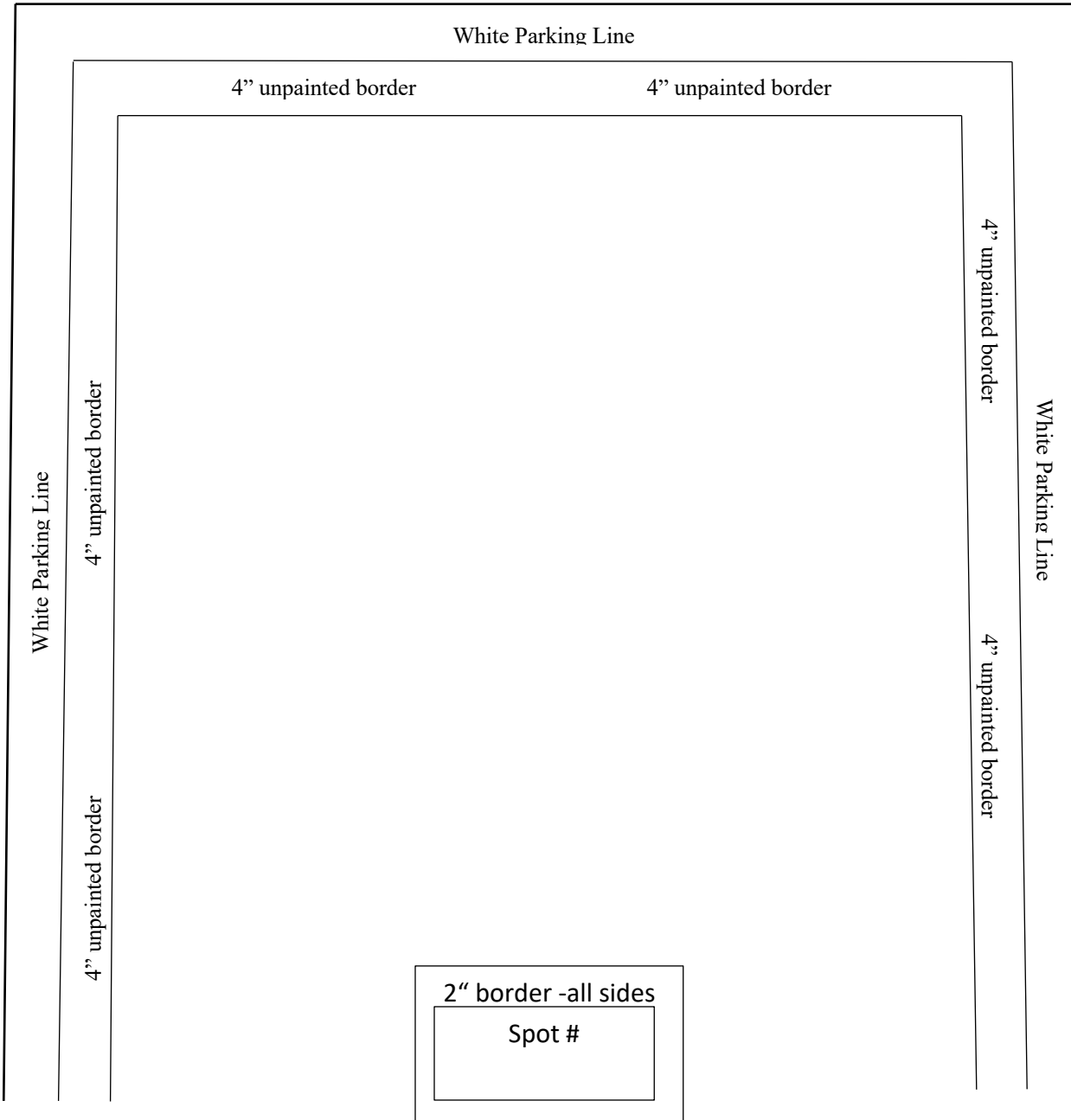
I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:

- I will only use water-based exterior latex paint.
- I understand that I must check-in at the check-in table before I start to paint.
- I know I am **NOT** allowed to use spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- I will only paint within my parking space leaving a 4-inch boarder between my drawing and the parking lines.
- I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot.
- I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space.
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my parking space.
- I understand that my painted design must be approved prior to me painting. A painting date will be announced and all painting must take place on that day, it will most likely be a Saturday.
- **If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will be taken away and will be painted over, and I will not receive a refund.**
- I agree to paint over my design in black water-based exterior latex paint at the end of the school year or pay the fee. This must be completed prior to senior check out. If I do not paint over my design, I understand I will have a \$20 fee.
