The elections for Homecoming Court will begin on Tuesday, October 21st with nominations. On that day, students will have the opportunity to nominate one female and one male student at their grade level. The nominations will be tallied and the students with the highest number of nominations will be placed on a ballot for the October 23rd elections. Each class will have the following number of students on the ballot: 4 (freshmen), 6 (sophomore), 8 (junior), and 10 (senior). On October 23rd, underclassmen will vote for one female and one male representative at their grade level and upperclassmen will vote for two female and two male representatives. The students with the most votes, as described above, will be the Homecoming Court Representatives.

For final court numbers, the freshmen will have a total of 2 representatives, 1 female and 1 male. The sophomore class will have a total of 4 representatives, 2 females and 2 males. The junior class will have a total of 6 representatives, 3 females and 3 males and the senior class will have a total of 8 representatives, 4 females and 4 males.

Additionally, the juniors will vote for Prince/Princess and the seniors will vote for King/Queen on Thursday, October 30th.

Homecoming Game Information

The Homecoming Game will begin at 7:30 p.m. Friday, October 31st. There will be various activities going on, apart from the game, and we encourage everyone to participate and attend.

Pep Rally: This will take place during 3rd period.

Fall Fest: 4:30-7:00 (Games)

Chef Webb and other clubs/organizations from WRHS will host the fall festival. Mrs. White will be providing the food for employees and their family members, but students and other community members may purchase plates from Chef. The clubs/organizations will have different booths with activities for youth including dunk tank, bounce house, snow cones, face painting, pumpkin painting, photo booth, etc.

<u>**Parade:**</u> This year the parade will take place during the half-time show of the football game. We want as many clubs/organizations/sports teams as possible to be involved. -Bulletin Board Decoration: 50 points

Each class will be assigned one of the student info. boards to decorate for Homecoming week. The decorating will take place Monday afternoon from 2-4 p.m.

-"Cans for a Cause": 50 points

Each class will sponsor will be collecting cans/non-perishable food items to donate to the ABC organization. The class who collects the most cans will be awarded the points.
