Notification of Out-Of-Field Teachers

October FCAT 2.0 Reading Retakes-FCAT, Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test, retakes will be administered October 6TH through October 17TH. These test dates are for Juniors and Seniors who have moved to Florida and have not taken the FCAT, Juniors and Seniors who have not passed FCAT, and retained Sophomores who have not passed FCAT. All students who are scheduled for FCAT retakes will receive testing information, including precise dates and locations, from their teachers. Students are encouraged to get a good night's rest and eat breakfast before coming to school on testing days.

PSAT

PSAT will be administered on Wednesday October 15th, 2014 here at Wiregrass Ranch High School. This is the <u>official</u> pre-test given by CollegeBoard, it is offered once a year and is the only way for Juniors to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program. We have a limited amount of tickets for 9th and 11th grade students, so they will be sold on a first come-first serve basis. All 10th grade students will be tested for free. Tickets for 9th and 11th grade students are \$15.00 and can be purchased according to the following schedule:

Juniors only:

Sold on September 29th and 30th in cafeteria first 20 minutes of all lunches October 1st-3rd, in student services

All 9th and 11th grade students:

October 6th and 7th, in cafeteria first 20 minutes of all lunches October 8th-10th, student services

Upon registration, students will receive a review booklet. Please be sure they take some time to look at this information prior to the test.
