

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program

Initial Eligibility for High School Applicants

**Students will complete the Initial Student Florida Financial Aid Application in the Fall of their Senior Year and submit it no later than Aug. 31st after graduation date. After submitting the FFAA, the student is responsible for tracking application and award status online and keeping the Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) informed of any demographic or institutional changes.
