August Statistic:

Students who graduate make approximately \$10,000 more per year.

DID YOU KNOW?

Even missing just 1 day of school can make a difference. Each day helps your child learn, grow, and stay on track. **Every school day really matters!**

Missing Just 2 days a month?

It might not seem like much, but over time it adds up. Your child could miss:

- Up to **20 days** of learning in a year
- 30 hours of crucial math instruction
- **60 hours** of essential reading and writing practice
- By graduation, that's over 1 full year of lost learning!

Missing 4 Days a Month?

The impact is even more serious. In just one school year, your child could lose:

- 40 days of learning
- 60 hours of critical math instruction
- 120 hours of vital reading and writing practice
- By graduation, that's more than 2 full years of missed education!

- Communicate with the school if your child must be absent
