12th Grade - Class of 2027 Frequently Asked Questions

How do I complete this Course Card?

For your 12th grade Course Card, please have your current core academic teacher initial next to one (1) of the courses for their subject area (English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies). During Senior year, you will take two (2) elective credits. Because you are not guaranteed your first choice, please select up to six (6) electives and number them in the order of preference (1-6). If a teacher recommendation is required (+), have your current teacher initial next to that course. Please do not write X's or check marks.

Can I take online courses?

If a student chooses to enroll in an online course as part of their WRHS schedule, the course can be taken on campus in the eSchool lab or off campus. If a student would like to take a course off campus, the off-campus placeholder must be placed at the beginning or end of the school day, and the student must have reliable transportation to/from campus each day. There must be a signed Late Arrival / Early Dismissal form on file with WRHS in order to take off-campus online courses. Students are not permitted to be on campus during an off-campus period of their schedule.

Do I have to take Personal Finance and Money Management?

The Personal Finance and Money Management course is required for high school graduation.

What is the Physical Education requirement for graduation?

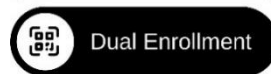
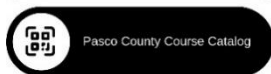
Health Opportunities through Physical Education (HOPE) is a course that completes the Physical Education requirement for graduation. This course can be taken in-person at WRHS or online throughout your high school career. Additional ways that students can complete the Physical Education requirement include: Completing the one-semester course, Personal Fitness, online (Pasco eSchool) and completing another Physical Education course (on-campus or online); participating on a WRHS athletic team for at least two seasons; participating in the WRHS band for two years. Please note: If earning your Physical Education requirement through participation in athletics or the band, the waiver does not provide a Physical Education credit – Instead, you will need to complete another elective credit to meet the 24-credit requirement for graduation.

Can I take Dual Enrollment courses?

It is highly recommended to have completed English Honors 2 prior to taking Dual Enrollment courses. This is because English Honors 2 builds important writing skills that support success in college-level coursework. Students are eligible to take Dual Enrollment courses as long as they meet two important criteria: 1) Have a 2.5 unweighted GPA for SLS 1106; 3.0 for all other Dual Enrollment courses and 2) meet minimum eligibility testing requirements on the PERT, SAT, ACT, or CLT. If you have PERT scores available, please attach them to your Course Card when submitting.

Where can I learn more information about the 2026-2027 school year at WRHS?

We will be holding a Curriculum Night on our campus for all students on January 29, 2026, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. This will be an opportunity to hear from WRHS staff members regarding courses, planning, and other important information to support your preparation for next school year.
