Frequently Asked Questions

Can I take online courses?

If a student chooses to enroll in an online course as part of their WRHS schedule, the course can be taken on campus in the eSchool lab or off campus. If a student would like to take a course off campus, the off-campus placeholder must be placed at the beginning or end of the school day and the student must have reliable transportation to/from campus each day. Students are not permitted to be on campus during an off-campus period of their schedule.

Can I enroll in AP courses during Freshman year?

9th grade students are able to enroll in AP courses; however, most of these courses require a teacher recommendation and/or certain prerequisites. Review the Pasco County Course Catalog via the QR code above for more information on AP courses you may be interested in taking throughout your high school career. AP Human Geography is an accessible AP-level course for 9th grade students and can prepare for future success in college-level courses.

Do I have to take Personal Finance and Money Management in 9th grade?

While students are not *required* to take the Personal Finance and Money Management course during Freshman year, this course is required for high school graduation. Freshman year offers a built-in opportunity to complete this course at the early stages of the high school career to keep students on track to meet credit requirements.

What is the Physical Education requirement for graduation?

Health Opportunities through Physical Education (HOPE) is a course that completes the Physical Education requirement for graduation. This course can be taken in-person at WRHS or online throughout your high school career. Additional ways that students can complete the Physical Education requirement include: Completing the one-semester course, Personal Fitness, online (Pasco eSchool) and completing another Physical Education course (on-campus or online); participating on a WRHS athletic team for at least two seasons; participating in the WRHS band for two years. Please note: If earning your Physical Education requirement through participation in athletics or the band, the waiver does not provide a Physical Education credit – Instead, you will need to complete another elective credit to meet the 24-credit requirement for graduation.

Where can I learn more information about the 2026-2027 school year at WRHS?

We will be holding a Curriculum Night on our campus for all students, including incoming Freshman, on January 29, 2026, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. This will be an opportunity to hear from WRHS staff members regarding courses, planning, and other important information to support your preparation for next school year. As a note, WRHS School Counselors do not have the capacity to meet with individual students and families for incoming students prior to the end of this school year. The Curriculum Night will offer an opportunity to meet WRHS faculty and learn more about the transition to high school.
