

Dress Code: Also review the Dress Code in the District Student Code of Conduct

- The dress code will be STRICTLY enforced! Clothing must be worn appropriately while on the school campus.
- All shorts and skirts should be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.
- Pants must be worn securely at the waist. Jeans may not have holes, tears, and/or rips more than 4 inches above the knee.
- Slippers are considered inappropriate footwear.
- Athletic wear worn during the school day/hours must comply with all school dress code standards.
- Sleep-wear, undergarments, low cut blouses, shirts and sweaters and see-through clothing are not allowed.
- Sleeveless apparel will not be allowed for boys. Tops and shirts must be long enough to remain tucked inside pants or skirts.
- Spandex including leggings will be permitted only if the outer garment meets dress code policy.
- Clothing or jewelry that is offensive or advertises violence, tobacco, alcohol or drugs are not permissible.
- Tank tops or halter-tops, dresses or clothing with thin straps (smaller than 3 inches) are not permissible.
- Hats, bandannas or head coverings, except for medical or religious reasons, are not permitted on campus.
- Hoods are only to be worn during inclement weather.
